- Proposed format and agenda
- Program Chairs, including a brief bio and contact information for each chair
- Tentative PC Committee list (optional)
- Expected number of submissions and accepted papers
- For workshops that were held previously, please include historical information such as previous venues, number of submitted papers, number of accepted submissions and number of registered attendees.
